
About the Programme

Assistant Professor Dorcas Quek Anderson - Yong Pung How School of Law, Singapore Management University

Dorcas is Associate Dean (Student, Staff & Alumni Affairs) and an Assistant Professor of Law in the Singapore Management University's Yong Pung How School of Law. As a practising mediator and a former District Judge in the State Courts, Dorcas' research is drawn from her experience and explores the interaction between dispute resolution developments and access to justice. Her research has been published in leading international journals including the Civil Justice Quarterly and the Harvard Negotiation Law Review. Dorcas has been accredited by the International Mediation Institute, Singapore International Mediation Institute, the Centre for Effective Dispute Resolution and the Singapore Mediation Centre. She is a mediator with Singapore International Mediation Centre, Singapore Mediation Centre, Asian Development Bank (Workplace Mediation) and the Global Mediation Panel at the Office of the Ombudsman for UN Funds and Programmes. Dorcas has conducted negotiation and mediation training in SMU, Attorney-General's Chambers, Singapore Mediation Centre and Singapore International Mediation Centre.



David MacArthur - Partner, Anderson Mori & Tomotsune

David is Co-head of the International Arbitration practice of Anderson Mori & Tomotsune, where he jointly oversees a large, diverse team spanning the firm's Pan-Asian office network.

A US national who began his career in US commercial litigation, David has spent the bulk of his career based in Asian, civil-law jurisdictions practicing as an international arbitration specialist. From 2006 to 2020, he was based in Seoul where his team was listed every year in GAR100 and several times in GAR30 or runner-up. He has acted as counsel in over 50 major arbitrations, often high-value and complex, seated in jurisdictions across Asia, Europe and North America and in a variety of industries, ranging from several million to several billion USD in value. In addition to commercial cases, he advises and represents clients in investor-state disputes.

He is also active as arbitrator and is presently empanelled with the HKIAC, JCAA, KCAB, AIAC and WIPO.
