## **Move to Vaccinated Travel Framework**



Border measures will be implemented based on travellers' vaccination status



Countries/regions will be classified under the General Travel or Restricted Category




All countries/regions are classified under the General Travel Category for now



Restricted Category will include countries which are significantly affected by variants with potentially significant public health risk

## From 31 March 2022, 2359 hours





- \* General Travel Category border measures for fully vaccinated land travellers will be announced separately.
- \* Travellers are subjected to Restricted Category border measures regardless of vaccination status if their 7-day travel history includes Restricted Category countries/regions.
- ^ There may be administrative, health and vaccination requirements that are in addition to or differ from the measures above. Check SafeTravel website for details.
- <sup>&</sup> Refer to https://go.gov.sg/remote-art-overseas-sg for a list of approved remotely supervised ART PDT providers, and the travellers and countries/regions that this service applies to.
- \* Travellers should isolate in their room and minimise contact with any household members, especially vulnerable household members. If this is not feasible, travellers or the vulnerable household members should consider alternative accommodation.
- <sup>®</sup> The charges for 7-day SHN at a dedicated SHN facility currently amount to \$1,015.
- <sup>+</sup> Travellers will be notified of their test appointment closer to the date of their exit PCR test.
