What is Ethics Assist?

Ethics Assist is a confidential helpline operated by the Law Society of Singapore. It is available to any lawyer seeking guidance and mentorship on ethical issues, regardless of seniority.

Why should I call Ethics Assist?

Younger lawyers utilising the Ethics Assist Helpline will be able to obtain guidance from senior practitioners who carry invaluable practice experience.

How does it work?

A lawyer who requires guidance on ethical issues can call Ethics Assist and outline the issue.

The Secretariat of the Law Society will anonymise the details and contact a senior practitioner for advice.

The senior practitioner will render the guidance through the Law Society, which will be conveyed to the lawyer.
