In the event parties agree to submit a Draft Consent Order or Judgment to the Court, this should preferably be reflected in writing in the settlement agreement, save that nothing herein shall preclude parties from agreeing that the terms of the settlement shall remain confidential such that the court proceedings be withdrawn or discontinued.
