WHEREAS

- I The Parties wish to attempt to resolve their disputes by non-binding neutral evaluation.
- II The Law Society and the Neutrals have agreed to provide non-binding neutral evaluation services to assist the Parties in resolving their disputes.

IT IS AGREED as follows:

1 SUBMISSION

- 1.1 The Parties agree and consent to the disputes arising out of or in connection with this claim being submitted to non-binding neutral evaluation scheme pursuant to the Law Society Neutral Evaluation and Determination Rules and the Law Society Neutral Evaluation Scheme – PIPD.
- 1.2 The Parties agree that a settlement in the terms of the Recommendations made by the

Neutrals shall not be binding unless it is reduced in writing and signed by the Parties.

- 1.3 The duly signed settlement agreement shall be binding upon the Parties in accordance with its terms save that any settlement agreements involving persons under disability shall be subject to the approval of the Court and parties shall be at liberty to disclose the settlement agreement to the Court for the purposes of any application for approval of the settlement. In the event parties agree to submit a Draft Consent Order or Judgment to the Court, this should preferably be reflected in writing in the settlement agreement, save that nothing herein shall preclude parties from agreeing that the terms of the settlement shall remain confidential such that the court proceedings be withdrawn or discontinued.
